

BIRTHDAY of CHRISTIANITY

The fifty days which follow Easter Sunday are still very much a part of the Easter Season within the annual Church's calendar. At the end of this prolonged period the Christian Church celebrates Pentecost (this year June 9th); commonly regarded as the Birthday of the Christian Church. On the original Pentecost, some 3,000 people are said to have been baptised into Christianity after hearing the disciples of Jesus preaching. Christianity was given a 'boost' as a faith, and launched as an evangelical religion. The early Church was very fond of feast days and holidays, and so Pentecost was always widely, (and wildly celebrated). Today the celebrations may be less so, but the colour red is often used to symbolise the spiritual energy and fire of the original Pentecost.

Since that first Pentecost; over these last 2000 years Christianity has spread throughout the world to every nation, and yet sadly is still the most persecuted of all faiths. It is widely recognised that Christians are at risk in well over 100 countries; with an estimation that more people died from their faith in the last century than all the previous ones put together.

Perhaps Christianity as a faith has not always endeared itself to those around it, and we remember such episodes in history as the strangely named 'Holy Wars.' But lest we forget, those acting in the name of Christianity can be far removed from the true faith itself as set out by its' founder Jesus Christ.

It is often said that here in England we live in a Christian country; that may or may not be true depending upon your interpretation. However, so much around us is of course a direct result of the Christian faith, even if from a time long forgotten. Our Feast Days of Easter and Christmas, the Parish system which is a part of every community, and where is there a village that does not support a Christian Church of one denomination or another?

We all know that Christianity has never had the monopoly on all that is good in this world, but has down the centuries so often been at the forefront of changes in our society which have left their mark for the good of all; think no further than the Social Reformers of the Victorian era who were invariably inspired by their Christian faith.

During the coming month of July the Church gives thanks for the life of Thomas Clarkson. Born at Wisbech in the late 18th Century, a one time resident at Bury St Edmunds, and finally laid to rest in Playford

Churchyard, where I was a Priest before coming to this Benefice. Thomas was motivated by his Christian faith, and worked tirelessly for the eventual abolition of slavery early in the 19th century. A man who travelled literally thousands of miles for the pursuit of justice, and nearly sacrificed his life on occasions in doing so.

Every July, at St Mary's Church Playford, we would hold a service of thanksgiving for the life of Clarkson, with a congregation made up from far and wide. A service of praise to a Christian who like his forbears on that first Pentecost Day took his inspiration and faith from Jesus Christ.

Walsham le Willows and District WI



April 2019

Our speaker at our April meeting brought us tales of heroism, of steadfast determination and of independent stout hearts. Since 1791 the residents of Caister on the Norfolk coast have put to sea to rescue other sea farers in a variety of boats. It seems in the beginning this enterprise had more than a little to do with salvage operations on the treacherous Scroby Sands.

However from these beginnings has evolved a unique independent lifeboat service supported by a team of fund raisers and benefactors, who ensure that Caister's life boat men continue to save lives. These days their craft is high tech. and speedy unlike the early boats powered by oars and muscles! The current craft powered by water jet engines is especially suited to the sand bars along the Caister shore. When in 1969 the RNLI sought to close the lifeboat station the total of 1,814 lives saved was greater than that of any other station in the British Isles and the public outcry and subsequent wave of support enabled the creation of the independent service that took over on the very same day and now guards this part of the coast. Don Hill, a dedicated Caister Lifeboat supporter, described for us the immense effort often needed just to launch the lifeboat, as the toughest of seamen ventured out into ferocious seas. Their proud history has earned them the famous battle cry" Caister men never turn back".

May 2019

The current President of Walsham le Willows and District WI was re elected unopposed at the Annual Meeting held in the Priory Room Walsham on May 8th. Members gathered to hear reports of the year's activities from the Committee and to adopt the financial statement presented by the Treasurer. Following this business, the events and opportunities available to members this month were outlined. These included an intriguing chance to do some "Welding with Chocolate". This will involve the challenge of building a chocolate bridge and testing its strength with weights to be organised by the new Suffolk West Federation WI Science and Technology Committee.

Debate on the two resolutions chosen for the NFWI Annual Meeting to be held in Bournemouth this year followed. The first calls for action to raise awareness of the importance of life-saving cervical screening, under the title "Don't fear the smear". Attendance is the lowest for a decade and particularly so for women aged 25 - 29, despite cervical cancer being the most common cancer among women under 35.

THE WESTHORPE TRUST

The Westhorpe Trust is made up of several historic funds. The oldest is from the will of Richard Brown in 1641, who lived in Westhorpe and left ten shillings a year to the poor of the parish. Income also came from the properties at Town Yard which in the 19th century contained the parish workhouse and some arable land at Botany Farm, Walsham le Willows.

The Trust's income is divided into three parts all for the benefit of the inhabitants of the parish:

1. **Westhorpe Parochial Church Council** for the upkeep and services for St Margaret's Church;

2. The **Education Foundation** which gives every child a book token at Christmas. Those at university, college or other forms of Further or Higher Education or apprenticeships are given grants each academic year towards tuition fees, travel expenses, books, computers and other essential equipment. Help is also offered with other expenses such as school uniform, books and possibly school trips for those in nursery, primary and secondary school as well as others taking educational courses.

3. The **Village Fund** provides family and personal grants for any kind of assistance, emergency payments, help with transport and heating costs, grants towards village events and many other things which need funding and are of benefit to the parish. 


